## With rotating classes

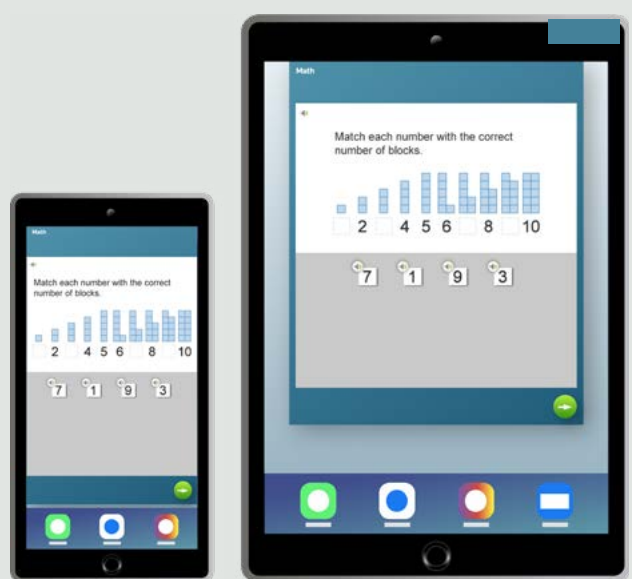

Students can use Moby on any device with an internet connection. Moby doesn't require a lot of bandwidth, so it works even when connected to a mobile hotspot.



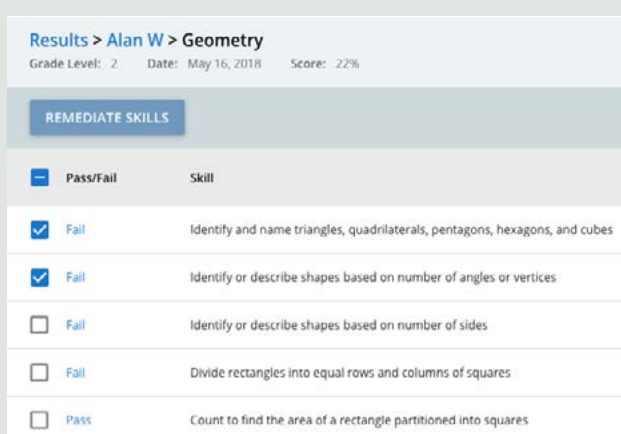
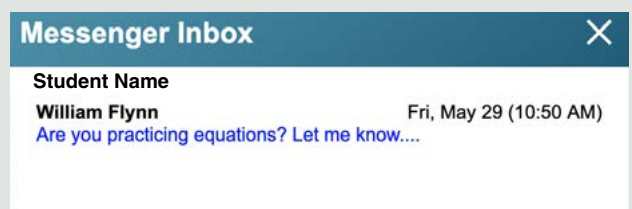
